

### Flosc Oibre - A Flurry of Activity

If Main Series volumes are necessarily slow in arriving, nevertheless, there has been considerable publishing activity. Firstly, all the volumes in the Main Series have been maintained in print. Secondly, the firm establishment of the ITS/UCC seminar in the annual calendar has resulted in a new volume of proceedings appearing each year.

The annual seminar relates, each year, to a volume in the Main Series. Distinguished scholars are invited to examine aspects of the volume in question and to consider it afresh in the light of the most recent scholarship.

As scholarship has developed considerably since many of these volumes were first published, these proceedings represent a valuable addition to the bookshelves of university teachers and students, as well as to the general reader. The

views of up to half a dozen experts are represented in each volume of proceedings; and each volume contains an up-to-date bibliography and a general index.

The seminars themselves, which take place at University College, Cork, at the beginning of November, represent an additional activity on the part of the Society, enjoyed by the academics, students and members who attend.

SS13 *Duanaire Finn:*Reassessments, edited by John Carey, with contributions from Pádraig Ó Riain, John Carey, Donald E Meek, Joseph Falaky Nagy, Máirtín Ó Briain, Ruairí Ó hUiginn

These are in addition to nine other titles in the Subsidiary Series, published from 1993 onwards, of which six form new introductions to volumes in the Main Series, and one of which is a companion volume to Beatha Bharra (volume 57).

In addition to these activities, the Society has also embarked on a joint publishing venture with the Locus Placenames Project. This is the publication in fascicle form of an *Historical Dictionary of Gaelic Placenames*, the first since Fr Hogan's *Onomasticon Goedelicum* (1910).

This is a project which will occupy the editors and the Society for a number of years to come. However, the first fascicle was launched in Dublin in February 2003.
