The Irish Texts Society values its link with London through its foundation there, and this is reflected in its activities.

In 2006, the Noel O'Connell Memorial Lecture was initiated to honour the memory of the Londonbased civil engineer Noel O'Connell, the ITS's Honorary Secretary from 1967 to 1991. This lecture is held in partnership with the Irish Literary Society, itself founded in London in 1892 - from a subcommittee of which the ITS emerged in 1898.

This year's lecture was delivered in April by Professor John Tuomey, of



UCD and O'Donnell and Tuomey Architects, on the subject of 'The Lyric Theatre Belfast', a project recently completed by his





architectural practice. His wide ranging presentation on aspects of architectural design drew many questions and contributions

> from the audience, including from actors and people involved in theatre, and those who were familiar with the building in its previous form.

Members of the O'Connell family

were present at the lecture and Noel's daughter, Emer, moved the vote of thanks to the speaker. Earlier, in March, the

inaugural ITS Breandán Ó Buachalla Memorial Lecture was delivered by Dr John Carey of UCC in the National Library of Ireland in Dublin.

The lecture has been instituted by the Society to commemorate the contribution of the late Professor Ó Buachalla to the ITS during his membership of Council between 1988 and 2010. In recent years Breandán had been concerned with the raising of the profile of the Society in the Dublin region - a project in which Dr Marc Caball of ITS Council has also taken a leading role. It is appropriate that this lecture should bear his name.

Dr Carey's lecture - 'The Wanderings of the Battle of Moytirra' - ranged in a masterly way across the history, contents and contexts of Harleian 5280, the older of two manuscripts on which an ITS bestseller, E A

Gray's edition of *Cath Maige Tuired/The Second Battle of Mag Tuired*, is based. Dr Carey's presentation referred to the manuscript tradition, Irish scribes and English antiquarians,

and mythic struggles and their meanings.

The lecture was attended by members of the Ó Buachalla family and was followed by an NLI-hosted wine reception.
